Together with Fuel a Dream, we distributed **817 ration kits** to not just fill stomachs but also, make sure adequate and critical nutritional needs are met during the crisis.

The only silver lining during this grave crisis has been how we were able to work with stakeholders to identify food insecurity hotspots and mobilize resources for emergency hunger relief and deliver the life saving needs well on time.
